Once all materials are received, your file will be sent for review to a program adviser, the chair and the dean. Some programs may require an interview with the faculty adviser.

Application checklist:

- 1. \$30 nonrefundable application fee payable to Niagara University.
- 2. Official transcripts of all colleges and universities attended in a sealed institution envelope included with your application. (If you have not yet graduated and/or your degree has not been conferred, please send an in-progress letter.)
- 3. Two references (academic or professional) in sealed envelopes with the referee's signature across the seal included with your application. (Please use the Niagara University reference form.)
- 4. Statement of Intent. Two-page, double-spaced, typewritten statement discussing your desired program-specific philosophy (ex. teacher education, educational leadership, special education, counseling, etc.), professional goals, objectives, strengths and weaknesses.

• **Teacher education, special education, and literacy** applicants are not required to take the Graduate Record Examination (General Test Score) or Miller Analogy Test, but applicants with an undergraduate GPA of less than 3.0 may be required to complete a personal interview and writing sample.

• **Mental health counseling and school counseling** applicants are required to take the GRE or MAT. Niagara University students/graduates with a final (or last two years of course work) GPA of 3.0 or above are not required to take the GRE/MAT.

• **School psychology** applicants, including Niagara University students /graduates, must take the GRE.

• **For individuals whose native language is not English, the TOEFL is required. A degree evaluation by WES (www.wes.org) is required for applicants who have obtained a degree outside of the United States or Canada.**

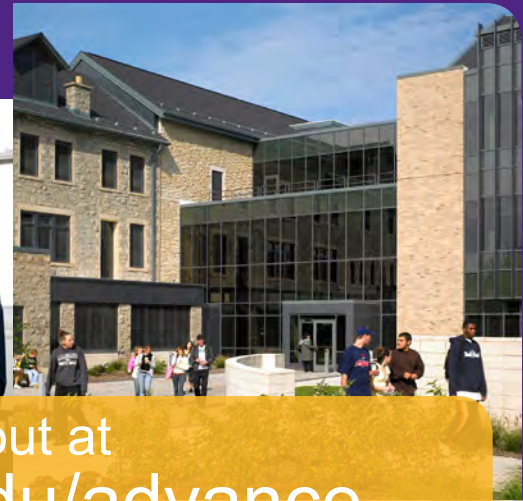
