- High school diploma/global equivalent AND 1,500 hours experience
- OR
- 23 hours project management education

### PMP® eligibility requirements

The PMP® certification exam prep course is designed for the experienced project manager who meets the eligibility requirements as established by PMI®. To take the PMP® certification exam, applicants must complete an application at: [www.pmi.org](http://www.pmi.org) and provide documentation of either:

- High school diploma/global equivalent, five years project management experience, 35 hours project management education
- OR
- Bachelor's degree/global equivalent, three years project management experience, 35 hours project management education.
