***Charges of the Standing Committees of the College***

**College Planning and Evaluation Committee**

Charge: To provide leadership for quality across the unit through planning and assessment for the College of Education. The College Planning and Evaluation Committee serves as the primary coordinating committee for the College of Education's strategic plan, assessment system, and accreditation.

**Program and Assessment Committee (College's curriculum committee)**

Charge: To facilitate the on-going development and approval of programs within the College. The Committee analyzes/approves new and revised curriculum for the College; leads the continuous examination and dissemination of the mission, goals, and conceptual framework of the College; and ensures that candidates in all programs are prepared with the knowledge, skills, and dispositions as delineated in program standards.

**Field Experience and Partnership Committee**

Charge: To facilitate the assessment process of the field experiences and clinical practices in the College of Education including analysis of data for program improvement and partnership development.

**Diversity Committee\***

Charge: To ensure that the curriculum, field experiences and assessments in all programs in the College of Education meet diversity outcome standards; ensure that faculty and staff are knowledgeable about diversity with access to current theory and practice; and ensure that faculty and candidates represent the balance of diversity inherent in our goals. \*  
*Includes international opportunities and study.*

**Faculty Qualifications, Performance and Development Committee**

Charge: To promote the best professional practices in scholarship, service and teaching through on-going assessment and evaluation, collaboration, and professional development for both full-time members of the faculty and staff and for adjunct professors. Objectives include a focus on the integration of instructional technology (objective 3).

**Advanced Research Committee**

Charge: To extend statistical operations and research design across faculties, serve as the liaison with the IRB and Research Council of the University, and to provide mentoring, professional development, and support on research to faculty and graduate students.
