^{*} There are additional charges for room damage deposit, single rooms, overload tuition, theatre course fees, laboratory fees, etc. Normal full-time semester program equals 15 credit hours. A student must be enrolled in at least 12 credit hours per semester to be considered full time. A student enrolled in more than 18 credit hours per semester will be assessed an additional tuition charge of \$1200 per credit hour. In calculating the overall cost of a degree program, it is important to remember that some majors require more than the standard 120 credit hours and, some majors may require students to take more than 18 credit hours in a semester. Students enrolled in these programs will incur additional charges at the per-credit hour rate. Students will also incur additional charges for non-credit developmental courses. Likewise, students should know that some majors require additional program fees (Business - \$555 per semester, Nursing - \$795 per semester, CIS - \$510 per semester, Theater Performance Fee - \$945 per class, etc.). Please check the hour requirements of your major before determining your costs and fees. Consult the NU Undergraduate Catalogue or NU's website for a complete listing of fees.
