\*If you need a paper FAFSA, you will need to call Federal Student Aid Information at 1-800-433-3243 and request one be mailed to you or you can download and complete a PDF FAFSA at [www.studentaid.ed.gov](http://www.studentaid.ed.gov) which must be mailed for processing.

\*\*Under federal regulations, the Financial Aid Office can no longer accept signed copies of tax returns. Federal regulations require either submitting the IRS tax transcript (see next page) or using IRS Data Retrieval through FAFSA on the Web at [www.studentaid.gov](http://www.studentaid.gov).

Per the IRS.gov website:

The Internal Revenue Service Data Retrieval Tool (IRS DRT) is available to use with the 2023–24 FAFSA Form. Additional security and privacy protections have been added to address concerns that data from the tool could be used by identity thieves to file fraudulent tax returns. The IRS DRT remains the fastest, most accurate way to input your tax return information into the FAFSA form.

### Getting Your 2021 Tax Return Information For the 2023–24 FAFSA

Applicants filing a 2023-24 FAFSA form must use federal tax information from their 2021 tax returns. They can do this by using the IRS DRT, or by referring to a copy for their 2021 tax return that they have in their possession.

You should always retain a copy of your tax return, either electronically or on paper, and keep it in a secure place.

If you did not keep a copy of your tax return, here are some options:

1. Access the tax software product you used to prepare and file your 2021 return. You may be able to access your account to download/print a copy.
2. Contact the tax preparer/provider who filed your 2021 return if you used a tax professional.
3. Download your tax transcript (a summary) at [Get Transcript Online](#). Review the rigorous identity authentication requirements for [Secure Access](#) before attempting to register.
4. Use [Get Transcript by Mail](#) and a transcript will be mailed to the address on your return within five to 10 days.
5. Call our automated line at [800-908-9946](#) to order a transcript by mail.

### What You Need

To use this service, you need your:

- [SSN](#) or [Individual Tax Identification Number \(ITIN\)](#),
- date of birth, and
- mailing address from your latest tax return

### What You Get

- Return or Account [transcript types](#) delivered by mail
- Transcripts arrive in **5 to 10 calendar days** at the address we have on file for you

## Request Online

### What You Need

To register and use this service, you need:

- your [SSN](#), date of birth, filing status and mailing address from latest tax return,
- access to your email account,
- your personal account number from a credit card, mortgage, home equity loan, home equity line of credit or car loan, and
- a mobile phone with your name on the account.

### What You Get

- All [transcript types](#) are available online
- View, print or download your transcript
- Username and password to return later
