Deadline & Expectations for NUSTEP Students



OVERVIEW DOCUMENT

All eligible students will register for their coursework by visiting the NUSTEP website at www.niagara.edu/nustep after the registration window opens. Only high school juniors and seniors are eligible to participate in the NUSTEP program.

Once the Registration Period (9/26/23-10/12/23) has ended, students will be able to pay for their course work. Detailed instructions for setting up a Purple Pass account and paying for these courses is available on the website. Students will have from 10/18/23 to 11/13/23 to pay for their courses. The cost of NUSTEP courses is \$95 per credit hour (\$285 for a 3 credit/\$380 for a 4 credit course).

Students who qualify for Free/Reduced Lunch are eligible to receive a reduced NUSTEP tuition rate of \$15 per credit hour (\$45 for a 3 credit course; \$60 for a 4 credit course). Students are asked to speak with their Guidance Counselor and provide proof of eligibility to qualify for tuition reduction. When registering, qualifying students should choose the "Free and Reduced" option in the payment section. Lists of students who qualify for Free/Reduced lunch need to be provided to the NUSTEP Office no later than Friday, Oct. 13, 2023 at 5pm.

Refunds are only available for the tuition paid during the billing period (10/18/23 to 11/13/23). Absolutely no refunds will be issued after 11/13/23.

IMPORTANT DATES AND DEADLINES

Tuesday, September 26, 2023	NUSTEP Registration portal opens - Students may register for courses
Thursday, October 12, 2023	NUSTEP Registration portal closes - No registrations accepted after this point
Wednesday, October 18, 2023	Students establish their PurplePass accounts, log-in and pay their bill on-line
Monday, November 13, 2023	PAYMENT DEADLINE: ALL COURSES MUST BE PAID IN FULL BY 5PM
Tuesday, November 14, 2023	ROSTER VERIFICATION DAY: All unpaid students will be deregistered from courses Any course dropped after this date will not be refunded. Students will receive a "W" for courses dropped from 10/25 until 11/30
Thursday, November 30, 2023	Last day to drop a course and receive a "W"; no refund issued.
Friday, December 1, 2023	Any course dropped hereafter will receive a grade of "U". <i>*This grade is not transferable and does/should not impact a student's future GPA</i>

Late Drop/Withdrawal Process

At any point on or after 11/14/23, students may withdraw from the class by sending an email to Niagara's registrar Harry Gong, hgong@niagara.edu indicating the course that they are dropping. A grade of W will be assigned until November 30th after which a grade of U will be assigned in December.
