#### The Certification

The Transitional D certificate is a certification issued by NYSED allowing candidates who do not have SDL certification practice in a position requiring SDL certification provided they meet the specific state requirements. The requirements were changed in July 2019 allowing candidates that have three or more years of experience teaching, pupil personnel service, or educational leadership in addition to candidates that do not have three or more years of experience teaching, pupil personnel service, or educational leadership. Niagara University assists qualified candidates in obtaining the Trans D certification so they can practice in an SDL related position while completing a course of study in school district leadership culminating in SDL certification.

In order to qualify for the Trans-D Certification candidates need to:

- 1. Obtain an employment commitment from a school district or BOCES for a position that required SDL Certification;
- 2. Have passed the New York State School District Leader Test, Part 1 and 2, and the Educating All Student (EAS) Exam;
- 3. Meet the requirements for a designation as "exceptionally well qualified" as determined by Niagara University and NYSED;
- 4. Be enrolled in the Niagara University SDL-Alternative 24 hour Certificate of Advanced Study Program.
