<p>1 Teacher Certification * Note: In order to obtain certification a school leader candidates must have a minimum of three years teach, pupil personnel service, or educational leadership experience.</p>	
<p>EDU 595 Educational Research & Statistics or equivalent Note: A course in research and statistics is required. Potential candidate's graduate transcript will be reviewed at time of admission. If an equivalent can't be found, candidates will be required to take EDU 595 as a Program Requirement.</p>
