## Required Sequence of Courses for Niagara University's New York State Education approved Clinical Mental Health Counseling Certificate of Advanced Study (CAS)/Bridge Program

Graduate students enrolled in Niagara University's Clinical Mental Health Counseling (CAS)/Bridge Program are required to complete a minimum of 15 graduate credit hours (five courses) in Counseling. Depending on courses completed during their previous counseling or related masters' degree, **applicants may be required to take additional graduate coursework** or substitute course work in the event they have taken some of the courses listed below.
