Student Dispositions Assessment Rubric – For Students

Dispositions are the tendencies to act and behave in certain ways under certain circumstances. Below are dispositional indicators of professional commitment and responsibility related to the field of teaching. You will be evaluated on these professional dispositions throughout your Teacher Education program at Niagara University.

#1 - Professional Commitment and Responsibility:

The candidate demonstrates a commitment to the profession and adheres to the legal and ethical standards set forth by it. The student:

- Maintains appropriate confidentiality
- Demonstrates compliance with laws/regulations/ policies/standards
- Maintains professional appearance
- Is prepared for class or appointments
- Is punctual for class or appointments
- Demonstrates honesty/academic integrity
- Models and promotes ethical and professional use of technology

#2 - Professional Relationships:

- Demonstrates personal progress through professional development to improve content and pedagogical knowledge
- Demonstrates reflective practice in written or verbal form
