There are additional charges for room damage deposit, single rooms, overload tuition, theatre course fees, laboratory fees, etc. Normal full-time semester program equals 15 credit hours. A student must be enrolled in at least 12 credit hours per semester to be considered full time. A student enrolled in more than 18 credit hours per semester will be assessed an additional tuition charge of \$1240 per credit hour. In calculating the overall cost of a degree program, it is important to remember that some majors require more than the standard 120 credit hours and, some majors may require students to take more than 18 credit hours in a semester. Students enrolled in these programs will incur additional charges at the per-credit hour rate. Students will also incur additional charges for non-credit developmental courses. Likewise, students should know that some majors require additional program fees (Business - \$585 per semester, Nursing - \$825 per semester, CIS - \$540 per semester, Theater Performance Fee - \$975 per class, etc.). Please check the hour requirements of your major before determining your costs and fees. Consult the NU Undergraduate Catalogue or NU's website for a complete listing of fees.

In addition to the charges listed above which are billed by the University, you should estimate the following annual additional expenses in your personal college budget.

STEP #1: First, enter the appropriate estimated charges: **Fall Semester Spring Semester** If you will be a commuter student, enter **\$20,065.** for fall semester and **\$19,790.** for spring semester on LINE A. If you will live on-campus, enter \$26,765. for fall semester and \$26,490. for spring semester on LINE A. A **STEP #2:** Second, list your financial aid awards from your Offer Letter in Self-Service. List the fall amounts in the fall column and the spring amounts in the spring column. FINANCIAL AID AWARD * TOTAL YOUR FINANCIAL AID AWARDS B -* (1) Federal Work-Study awards may NOT be used as a deferment toward tuition, fees, food & housing charges unless you make special arrangements with the Student Accounts Office. Because you will receive your own pay check every two weeks, you should determine in advance what portion of your pay check will be applied to the charges on Line A and what portion will be used for your own personal expenses. If you determine that any portion of your pay check is to be used toward paying the charges on Line A, include only that amount of your work-study award in Step #2, otherwise write in zero. A special deferment form will be available in the Student Accounts Office prior to the beginning of the semester. Your Federal Direct Loan amount (subsidized & unsubsidized) may be reduced by up to 1.057% as an origination/default fee **(2)** by the federal government. Write in your loan amount less 1.057%. For example, if your loan is \$1,750, per semester, write in \$1,732. for each semester (\$1,750. less 1.057%). **(3)** If you are rejecting an award, write in zero for that award amount. **STEP #3:** Third, subtract the total of your financial aid awards (Line B) from the amount on
