Transfer I-20 Request Form

Information: If you are eligible for a transfer I-20 and are admitted to a full-time program at Niagara University, you must request that your school transfer your electronic F-1 SEVIS record to us so that we can issue a transfer I-20 for you. A “SEVIS transfer” is different from an “academic transfer.” The transfer of your SEVIS record can take place at the same degree level or when you are changing levels (e.g. BA to MS). The transfer process must be completed within 60 days of the completion of your previous program.

There are several benefits to a SEVIS transfer vs a new initial I-20:

- You maintain the same SEVIS ID number
- You do not pay another SEVIS fee for a new SEVIS record
- You may remain in the U.S. in between programs
